# Introduction



- Learning styles refer to the preferred way an individual processes, understands and retains information.
- People learn differently and recognizing these styles helps improve teaching and learning experiences.

- Kinesthetic



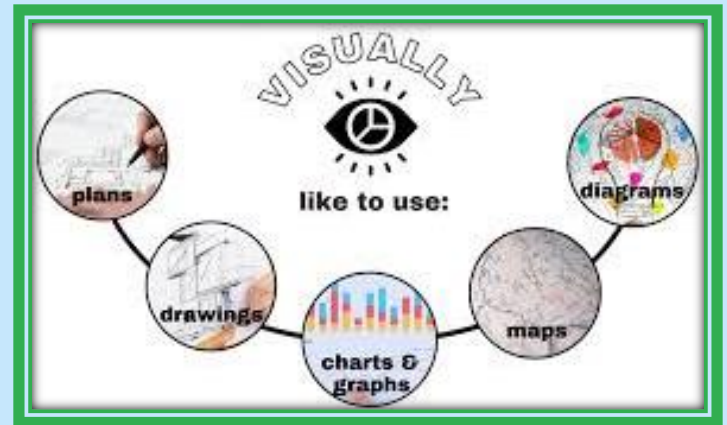
# Visual Learners



- Prefer to see information
- Learn best through: Diagrams, Charts, Mind Maps, Videos, Illustrations

## Tips for learning

- Use color-coded notes
- Replace words with symbols or drawings
- Visualize information using charts, flow charts etc.



# Auditory Learners



- Learn through Listening and Speaking
- Benefit from Lectures, Discussions, Podcasts, Verbal instruction.



## Tips for learning

- Read aloud
- Discuss topics with peers
- Use rhythm, rhymes and mnemonics

# Reading/Writing Learners



- Prefer text-based input and output
- Learn best with: Books, Handouts, Lists, Written Explanations.



## Tips of learning

- Take and rewrite notes
- Create to-do and concept lists
- Summarize concepts in written form

# Kinesthetic Learners



- Learn through doing, touching, moving etc.
- Prefer Hands-on activities, Experiments, Real-life examples

## Tips for learning

- Incorporate Role plays
- Use models or props
- Incorporate movement into learning sessions



# Multimodal Learners



- Combine two or more learning styles
- Adapt learning methods depending upon the task
- Use a mix of techniques – read, listen, watch and do



# How to identify your Learning Style



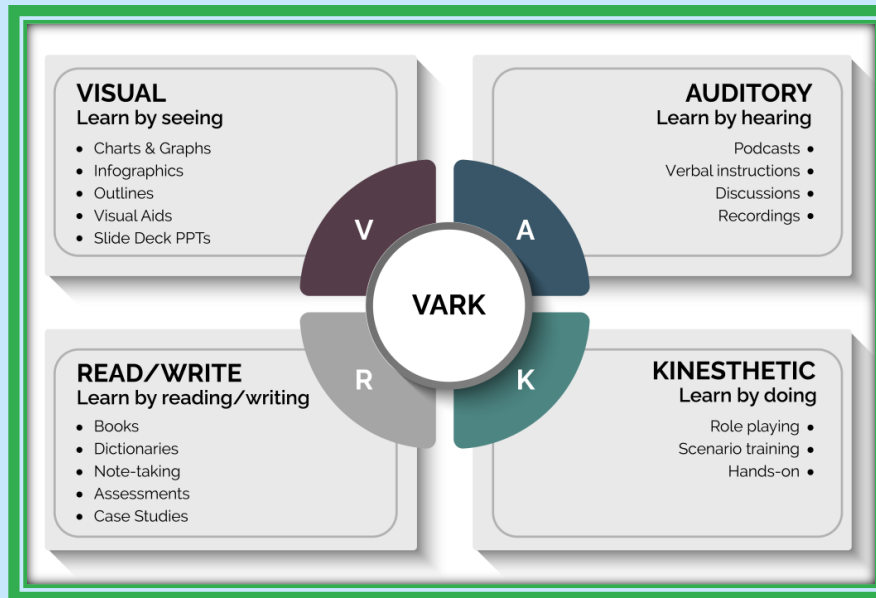
- Reflect on past learning experiences
